Medical Indications

Indications are suggested use only, WIMBA defers to prescribing clinician for clinical decisions.

WIMBA Carpus Orthosis:

- Carpal hyperextension (compensatory, ligament, or tendon condition)
 - o mild cases
 - maximum angle in extension: 205 degrees
- · Osteoarthritis in the carpal joint
- Rehabilitation Therapy (variety of uses)
- Prevention for numerous situations
- Support for obese dogs

Distal strap is placed 4.5cm from the carpal joint - we will not accept patients with smaller limbs (Minimum= 11cm limb circumference).

The number of proximal straps (1 or 2) will be based on the measurements submitted.

Red Flags

(Cases Not Suitable for Carpus Orthosis)

- Deformation of the joint
- Joint rebuilt
- Deformation of digits
- Medial or lateral instabilites

WIMBA Tarsus Orthosis:

- Tarsal hyperextension (compensatory, ligament, or tendon condition)
 - o mild cases
 - maximum extension: 180 degrees)
- Tarsal hyperflexion (Achilles tendon/CCT injuries with no complete tear present)
 - mild cases
 - o maximum flexion: 90 degrees
- Osteoarthritis in the tarsal joint
- Rehabilitation Therapy (variety of uses)
- Prevention for numerous situations
- Support for obese dogs

Distal strap is placed 4.5cm from the tarsal joint - we will not accept patients with smaller limbs at this time (Minimum= 11cm limb circumference).

The number of proximal straps (1 or 2) will be based on the measurements submitted.

Red Flags

(Cases Not Suitable for Tarsus Orthosis)

- Deformation of the joint
- Joint rebuilt
- Deformation of digits
- Medial or lateral instabilites













For 2- and 3-strap tarsus or carpus orthoses, WimbaBOX and WimbaSCAN are no longer required.




